2023 Updates from Mother Church

Branch Monthly Check-In

Mother Church wants to support our branches, so we ask if each branch can send us a quick update every month. This is separate from any information we request for the newsletter. One or two sentences letting us know what you're doing, how the branch is doing, and how your presidency is functioning. Information from you helps us to know what support you may need from Mother Church. Please have your Chiefs of Staff send us an email every month.

Virtual Membership Cards

For 2023 we would like to reduce our carbon footprint by no longer using unnecessary plastic and ink with ONAC membership cards. Beginning January 2023, ONAC will be moving to virtual membership cards. We believe this is the aligned way forward in honoring our Mother Earth and modern times to make membership status more accessible for ONAC branch leaders and ONAC members. Any active and good standing member of ONAC will shortly be able to request a virtual card, if they wish. This includes our branch presidency members and medicine people as well. However, all new members in 2023 and moving forward will only receive virtual cards. All virtual cards will be sent through email.

Each new member will receive a 'Welcome Email' that will include their virtual card. There will be instructions to save the email as well as also being able to download an image of the virtual card to save in their photos on their phone.

On each virtual membership card, there will be an additional QR code on the front. This code will link to the members record and show their membership status. Branch leaders with a login to the ONAC database will be able to scan this QR Code to look up a member's standing, even if they are not a member attached to their branch. Every ONAC branch presidency will shortly receive instructions on how to check membership status for people coming to ceremony.

Updated Cannabis Policy

Many states in the United States have legalized cannabis for medical use, and several have made it completely legal for any purpose. In those states where cannabis is legal, you may follow the laws of your state. However, in states where there are still limitations, you must follow our sacrament limitations.

An ONAC member may not have more than 2 ounces of Cannabis Sacrament at any time. NOTE: During harvest time, a member may have more than 2 oz in their possession, as they have likely grown enough medicine to last for the season.

All medicine over 2 ounces must be put into sealed containers and labeled with the date of harvest and your name and ONAC membership number, and either stored in the freezer or a lockbox with an ONAC sticker on it.

It is vitally important that every member growing cannabis understands that this is sacred medicine and cannot be sold or gifted to anyone within or without Oklevueha. The personal cultivations are for personal sacramental and medicinal use only.

It is with great excitement and gratitude that we bring to you an amazing new opportunity and source for all members of Oklevueha Native American Church. We are so blessed to now have a formalized education source for our branches, members, facilitators, and anyone interested in learning or expanding their already existing experience in indigenous modalities.

As you know, we hold these medicines and ceremonies sacred. ONAC members and Branches are vetted in a way that helps us protect the medicine as well as the opportunity to participate in life changing ceremonies. We know that it is incredibly important to make sure that our Medicine Men and Women are well rounded in their experience and education. This offers safety to those sitting as well as those facilitating.

ONAC University (www.onacuniversity.org) has taken on the mission of helping to bring forward a formalized education system for our members to specifically preserve the sacred traditions of medicines, healing modalities, and education in areas that can often be missed in a general apprenticeship setting.

Enrollment is open and students can begin

registering for classes that begin in January. New cohorts will start each quarter and there is space for all to participate. Whether you want to do some continuing education or enter the commitment of becoming a Doctor of Indigenous Medicine, there is something for everyone. We are in the process of receiving accreditation publicly and privately, so coursework can be used in both the public and private jurisdiction.



Residency programs and student apprenticeships will also be offered and part of certain courses. This will happen in our ONAC of The Lotus Sanctuary clinic in Utah. All members of our ONAC community can attend our facility as we only work within the membership. (www.lotussanctuary.com)

Lastly, ONAC University of Indigenous Medicine is a non-profit so all payments will be credited as a donation and can be used as a deduction on your taxes. And, an even more incredible bonus, as we work with several different cultures, a Polynesian Non-profit organization called Village Impact that has partnered with GoSponsr has created an opportunity for those that may need some assistance in tuition or funding. Oklevueha Legal Defense Fund

Oklevueha Native American Church has been on the forefront of legal rulings protecting the freedom of religion and our constitutional rights. One of our own has been in a five-year legal battle with the

state of Hawaii, and we are coming to you to ask for your help and support as he appeals the ruling against him.

Wes Sudbury is an ONAC Branch leader and ONAC medicine person who has been caught in a riptide of legal issues and illegalities. Wes was held in Hawaii for six and a half years in a federal prison without a speedy trial, with various legal representatives that refused to fully support Wes, many delays, pressure from the court to take a plea deal, and numerous other ridiculous scenarios.

Please help Wes to finish this, and with the aid and protection of The Great Spirit, provide victory and healing for the nations. This, of course, has been a significant sacrifice of struggle and pain for him and his family financially and otherwise.

These are some of the illegal activities that were perpetrated against him:

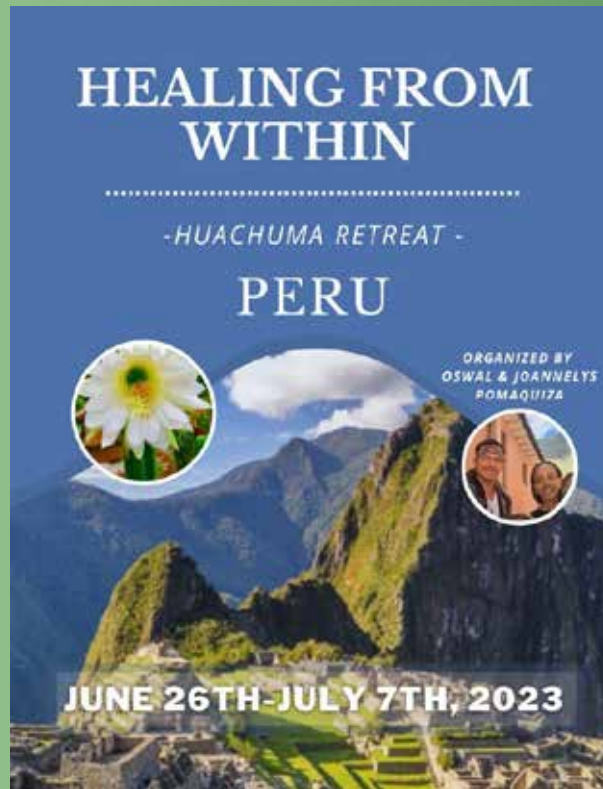
- He was originally told by law enforcement in Hawaii county that his church was beneficial to the community and not on the law enforcement radar. They then sent a confidential source, into the private areas to engage in electronic surveillance for years, while encouraging them to go bigger, violating multiple state and federal constitutional and statutory rights.
- The Hawaii office got a wiretap warrant with this illegal evidence. This was a violation of supreme court precedent and the 4th amendment. They ignored the compelling interest standard through all this, the judge refused to follow the statutes binding her order to the government to provide discovery of all the activity before the DEA became involved.
- After serving the most time he would have gotten, had he been convicted, the judge then demanded to have a trial.
- The County of Hawaii sent a confidential informant into the private areas of his church and set up electronic surveillance for years on the church property.
- The County of Hawaii enticed the DEA into reopening their Hawaii office, who got a wiretap warrant with this illegal evidence.
- The County of Hawaii ignored the Government Compelling Interest standard that is required when dealing with a church.
- The Judge refused to follow the statutes binding her to order the government to provide discovery of all the activity before the DEA became involved.
- One of his attorneys did not file a crucial paper with the court because "the line was too long." His attorneys made so many errors that even the judge suggested they be fired.
- After Wes' case was accepted by the U.S. Supreme Court, the judge in Hawaii rushed through a trial and brought him to a conviction, thus making his appeal to the Supreme Court moot. Even after serving five years, Wes is now on probation for three years.

Wes' only recourse is to launch an appeal of his conviction with the Federal courts in Hawaii. His goal is to have his original conviction thrown out, and his probation removed. This case, and the ultimate outcome could drastically impact all members of ONAC.

Wes is asking for assistance to finish this, and with the aid and protection of The Great Spirit, provide victory and healing for the nations.
